Duck Design Details

KEEPING ALL YOUR DUCKS IN A ROW: THE RULES!

- Artists may alter the basic duck form, but cannot compromise its structural integrity. The contact points by which the ducks are attached to their bases cannot be altered or obstructed.
- Artists may paint, sculpt, transform or adorn the ducks. Objects attached to the ducks must be affixed so that they cannot be easily removed. Attached objects must be weather-resistant.
- Artists have the option of adding appendages to the fiberglass form. Proposed additions must be made clear at the time of the original design submission to the *Ducks In A Row* Committee.
- Ducks may be placed in outdoor areas for two months, September and October and will be accessible to the public. Artists should consider weather, exposure and public safety when determining design and materials. Remember, people (especially children) may be touching these sculptures!
- Artists should also recognize that their sculptures might be purchased at the auction in the fall, for possible placement in a permanent outdoor location.
- *Ducks In A Row* will apply a protective clear coat of autobody finish to the ducks prior to their debut on the streets of Verona. This will take place after receiving the finished sculpture from the artist.
- Designs MUST be appropriate for public display. Designs that are religious, political or sexual in any way will not be accepted.
- Corporate logos and advertising are not permitted. The *Ducks In A Row* Committee will evaluate all design submissions and has sole discretion to accept or reject any designs they deem offensive or inappropriate for public display in Verona.
- Upon receipt of unfinished duck form, artists will be given a list of helpful hints for decorating the ducks from Cowpainters, Inc., the manufacturer of the fiberglass forms.
- Artists will also have access to the "Artist Help Line" at Cowpainters to assist them with questions about materials.
- This event is being organized by the Verona Chamber of Commerce. The event will benefit all of Verona, bringing together the community, business owners, residents and town officials.
